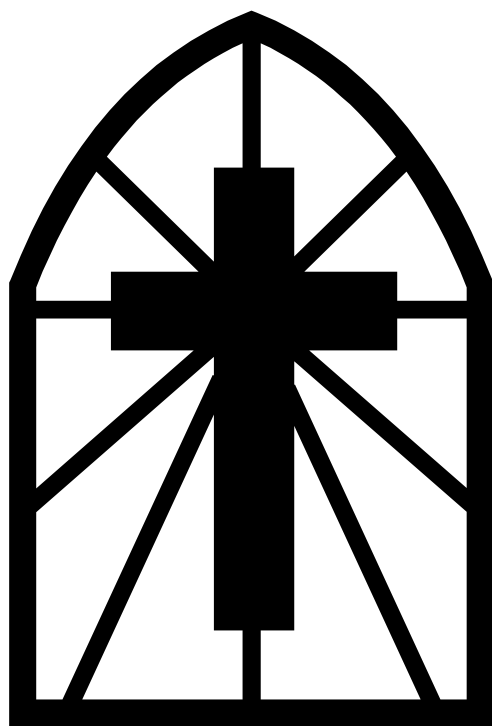

ABRAHAM AND LOT

9 The Third Article of the Apostles' Creed

I believe in the Holy Spirit; the Holy Christian church, the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting.

GOD PROMISES ABRAHAM A SON

10 The First Commandment

You shall have no other gods.

What does this mean?

We should fear, love and trust in God above all things.

GOD ANSWERS ABRAHAM'S PRAYER

11 The Second Commandment

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not use His name to curse, swear, lie or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God's name in every trouble, pray, praise and give thanks.

GOD TESTS ABRAHAM'S FAITH

12 Matthew 22:37 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

ABRAHAM'S SERVANT FINDS A WIFE FOR ISAAC

13 Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

JACOB TRICKS ISAAC

14 1 John 1:17 The blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all sin.

JACOB'S DREAM

15 The Eighth Commandment

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, or give him a bad name, but defend him, speak well of him, and take his words and actions in the kindest possible way.

JACOB AND LABAN

16 Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.

JACOB RETURNS TO CANAAN

17 The Tenth Commandment

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, workers, animals, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not force or entice away our neighbor's spouse, workers, or animals, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

JOSEPH IS SOLD BY HIS BROTHERS

18 Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation.

JOSEPH IN POTIPHAR'S HOUSE AND IN PRISON

19 Genesis 39:9 How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God?

JOSEPH BECOMES RULER OF EGYPT

20 Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him.

JOSEPH'S BROTHERS COME TO EGYPT

21 Ephesians 3:20 [God] is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine.

JOSEPH TESTS HIS BROTHERS

22 Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

JOSEPH FORGIVES HIS BROTHERS

23 The Fifth Commandment

You shall not murder

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.

JACOB BRINGS HIS FAMILY TO EGYPT

24 Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord.

BABY MOSES

25 Psalm 124:8 Our help is in the name of the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth.

MOSES LEAVES EGYPT

26 1 Peter 5:8 Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

GOD CALLS MOSES

27 Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God.

PHARAOH DOES NOT OBEY GOD

28 Luke 11:28 Blessed are those who hear the word of God and obey it.

THE PLAGUES

29 Psalm 14:1 The fool says in his heart. “There is no God.”

33 Psalm 145:15 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time.

34 2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is God-breathed.

THE GOLDEN CALF

35 Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith.

THE TABERNACLE

THE DAY OF ATONEMENT

37 The Third Commandment

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it.

THE TWELVE SPIES

38 Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

39 The Lord’s Prayer

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, now and forever. Amen.

MOSES’ SIN AND THE BRONZE SNAKE

40 Matthew 28:20 Surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

BALAAM BLESSES THE ISRAELITES

41 Matthew 4:10 Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.

THE ISRAELITES ENTER CANAAN

42 Revelation 2:10 Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life.

RAHAB AND THE SPIES

43 Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear, for I am with you.

THE FALL OF JERICHO

44 Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

ACHAN'S SIN

45 The Ninth Commandment

You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or obtain it by a show of right, but do all we can to help him keep it.

THE SUN STANDS STILL

46 Matthew 6:33 Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

THE ISRAELITES TURN AWAY FROM GOD

47 The Seventh Commandment

You shall not steal.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property, or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.

GOD CHOOSES GIDEON TO LEAD ISRAEL

48 Psalm 56:11 In God I trust; I will not be afraid.

GOD GIVES GIDEON VICTORY

49 1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

SAMSON

50 The Sixth Commandment

You shall not commit adultery.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we lead a pure and decent life in words and actions, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.

SAMSON'S SIN AND DEATH

51 Luke 18:13 God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

RUTH'S FAITH

52 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you.

RUTH AND BOAZ

53 Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him and He will do this.

GOD ANSWERS HANNAH'S PRAYER

54 Matthew 7:7 Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

ELI AND HIS WICKED SONS

55 The Fourth Commandment

Honor your father and mother that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve and obey them, and give them love and respect.

SAUL BECOMES KING

56 1 John 4:19 We love because he first loved us.

57 Genesis 39:9 How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God?

DAVID AND GOLIATH

58 Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart.

DAVID AND JONATHAN

59 Galatians 5:13 Serve one another in love.

DAVID SHOWS KINDNESS TO SAUL

60 1 John 3:15 Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer.

THE DEATHS OF SAUL AND JONATHAN

61 Matthew 22:39 Love your neighbor as yourself.

DAVID SINS

62 Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation.

ABSALOM SINS AGAINST DAVID
